

## **Condition Red**

The following policy will be followed should the President of the United States decide that the country is elevated to Condition Red, indicating a sever risk of terrorist attacks.

**County Departments are strongly encouraged in the case of a Condition Red to lock all building entrances and post notices that the building is closed to the general public. Employees will remain at their work locations during normal work hours. Access to buildings should be generally limited to employees, with common sense exceptions. A decision on continuing in this “lock down” mode will be made based upon the nature of the threats that precipitated the Condition Red warning, and updated information from state and federal officials.**
