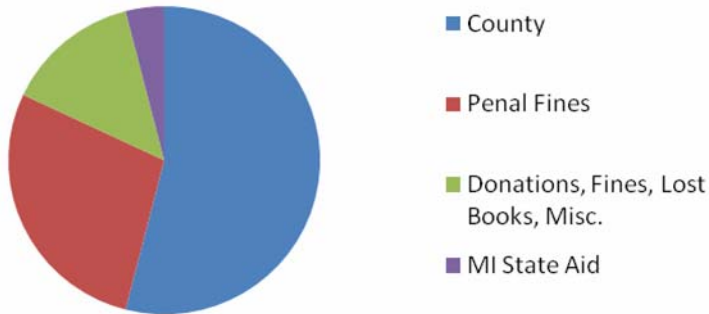
# *Statistics for the Lenawee County Library*
